Dear customer on the Diamond Point water system,

5/25/23

We have an update for the current boil advisory that is in place, and unfortunately it's not the news we were hoping to share.

The follow-up sample (that was collected at the same site as the previous sample) came back absent of E. coli (meaning no E. coli), but Unsatisfactory for total coliform. This is good news in terms of the absence of E. coli, however because the total coliform sample didn't pass, we are unable to lift the boil notice at this time, and it will remain in place through the weekend.

We have been in direct communication with the Department of Health as well as Clallam County Health Department. Here are the main points that are being required of us before the boil advisory can be lifted:

- **Participate in a Special Purpose Investigation (SPI) within two business days.** This is scheduled for tomorrow (Friday) afternoon.
- **Correct issues identified during the assessment/SPI.**
- **Collect additional coliform samples.** Collect two sets of five satisfactory samples (collected on different days), under normal operating conditions, before the Health Advisory can be lifted.

We will continue to chlorinate the system all weekend, and as mentioned above the boil advisory will remain in place through the weekend. We will provide another update tomorrow after the Special Purpose Investigation with the health department to let you know of any findings. If you have any questions, please let us know. Our office is closed for the night but we will respond first thing tomorrow morning.
